Consequently, in the above-mentioned period, the share of women in the Company's Management Board was 14,29% as compared to the 85,71% share of men.

As a result of the submitted resignations, Hatice Ayas and Dražen Pehar are no longer members of the Company's Management Board as of 31 December 2013 (the Company informed about that fact in the current report no. 31/2013 on 19 December 2013). Therefore, since 31 December 2013 no woman is a Member of the Company's Management Board.

In the period from 1 January 2012 to 31 December 2013, the Company's supervisory functions were performed by seven Members of the **Supervisory Board**, including one woman – Gabriela Żukowicz. Consequently, in the above-mentioned period, the share of women in the Company's Supervisory Board was 14,29% as compared to the 85,71% share of men.
